Outdoor Plumbers & Other Vendors



It has come to our attention that homeowners are hiring plumbers to do plumbing work that do not know our community. The plumber breaks an outdoor pipe and the plumber has no idea how to shut off the water to the building. There have been instances where water has spewed for awhile and plumbers have shut off the entire community which should not be done. This also results in the HOA incurring the water charges for the water spewing until it gets turned off, repairs for HOA piping and the HOA having to hire HOA plumbers to inspect the outdoor work that the homeowner's plumber has done.

To combat this from happening, we have decided to have an approved plumbing list for OUTDOOR plumbing projects only. Please be on the look out for an approved vendor list that you will

be able to refer to when hiring plumbers to work. Homeowners can be held responsible for any damages that their plumber causes to HOA piping.

Also, please help us be diligent when working with internet/cable companies to ensure that the workers are replacing the protective covers back over the wires on the sides of your homes. Often times these wires are not covered and this could be potentially dangerous.

2024 Budget

The board had a preliminary budget meeting and are in the process of making a few changes. There will be NO increase to the 2024 monthly maintenance fees.

New Pool Hours

Beginning November 5, the pool hours will be 7:00 a.m. until 5:30 p.m.

Please note that there are cameras in the pool area that set off alarms. There is a fee for anyone that jumps the pool fence or occupies the pool area after hours.
